Looking after you and us

- Please do not come to the farm if you have a respiratory illness, or diarrhoea and vomiting
- We will maintain a safe distance from you, while still making you feel very welcome
- You are welcome to come and collect beef but please phone Chris first (07749 040660)
- We will launch boats for our moorings' owners from here, but this must be arranged in advance

Boats are back on the moorings, but all our moorings are all taken for 2020. If you want to put your name on a waiting list, then please send an email to info@portnellanfarm.co.uk with your name; your mobile no; the type of boat and its length.

- When coming down to launch, please keep in touch with David (07736 666274) prior to arriving at the farm
- On arrival, please check how many vehicles are on the shore; wait for cars to come up before driving down.
- Vacate the shore as quickly as possible to prevent a queue forming.
- Please do not park in front of machinery or boats.
- Max 1 car per mooring at the farm. Parking for additional cars at Pumping Station.
- Please speak to David if you are unsure where to park.
- Please be mindful of those around you...and respect people's personal space on the shore and pier
